Fossils are impressions of the remains, or pieces of the remains, of an ancient (super old) organism, in a rock!

A fossil can preserve an entire organism or part of one, like a piece of bone, a shell, a feather or even a leaf.

A fossil can leave clues to the past and help us learn about species that were here many, many years ago.

Un fossile peut laisser des indices sur le passé et nous aider à en apprendre plus sur les espèces qui étaient ici il y a très très longtemps.

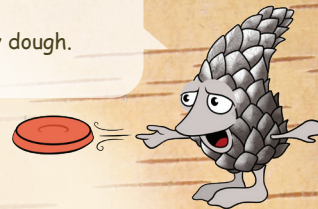

At home, try pressing a rock, shell, or feather into a piece of play dough.
When the play dough hardens, you've created a fossil!



Clue: Make your way east across the bridge on Arundel Street and go down to the second parking lot off Lyon Street. There you will find the post overlooking the water and the rock along the river edge.
