

The tree Farm (Pennock Creek North)



Scientists measure trees to learn about growth patterns in different weather and seasons.

Tree growth is measured by wrapping a measuring tape around a tree AND by taking core samples. A core sample is a non-invasive way to take a piece of the tree from the middle so we can count the rings.

Ferme forestière (Nord du ruisseau Pennock)

Les scientifiques mesurent les arbres afin d'en apprendre davantage sur leurs habitudes de croissance sous différentes conditions climatiques et saisons. La croissance de l'arbre est mesurée en enroulant un ruban à mesurer autour de l'arbre ET en prenant des échantillons. Un échantillon est une méthode non invasive pour prendre un morceau du milieu de l'arbre afin d'en compter les anneaux.
